7. The party of the second part will not comitt or permit to be committed any waste whatever on said premises, and shall not remove or tear down any improvements thereon, or destroy any other property, but agrees to keep in good repair all of the fences, and reset post where ever new post are needed and any violation thereof shall render this lease immediately void and intitle the party of the first part to possession with out notice.

8. All work and labor in the cultivation of said land shall be done in first class style and with due regard to the production of the best possable crops and the following crops shall be planted Corn, Oats and Wheat.
