then this grant shall become null and void, unless second party shall thereafter pay at the rate of eighty dollars annually in advance, for each year such completion is delayed.

The second party shall have the right to use sufficient gas or water, to run all machinery for operating said wells, and also the right to remove all its property at any time.

If second party fails to operate said well or wells continuously for twelve months then this lease will become null and void. It is further agreed that in any event at the expiration of thirteen years this lease will become null and void.

It is understood between the parties to this agreement that all conditions between the parties hereunto shall extend to their heirs, successors, executors and assigns.
