The court further finds that before sale the guardian; herein, filed a'n additional. Guardian's bond as the law regires, and the same as in due form and was duly approved by this court.

The court further finds that the decree of sale in the above entitled cause was made by the court for the reasons set out in the guardian's petition for sale, and for the reasons set out in the said decree of sale.

The court further finds that on the 8 day of June 1910, a day within six months after the date appointed for the said sale, bids were opened by the guardian, herein and it was found that S.P. Swisher had bid the sum of Five Hundred & no/100 dollars for the above described lands which was at least ninety per cent of the appraised value thereof, and that being the highest and best bid for the said land, the same was accordingly sold to the said S.P.
