Wynn, her heirs and assigns forever, the following described lands in the Cherokee Nation and in the Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit: Lot No. 570, in Block No. 45, of Tulsa Heights, according to a map or plat thereof used by the Tulsa Heights Company and filed for record and recorded in the office of the Clerk of the United States Court and ex-officio Recorder, at Tulsa, Indian Territory, the same being a part of that portion of the west half (W 1/2) of the Southwest Quarter (SW 1/4) and the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SW 1/4 of the NW 1/4) of Section Twenty nine (29) Township Twenty (20) North, Range Thirteen (13) East.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Mrs. M.F. Wynn, her heirs and assigns forever, together with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging; and for the consideration aforesaid, I, R.W. Carroll, covenant and agree to and with the said Mrs. M.F. Wynn, her heirs and assigns forever, that I will forever warrant and defend the title to said lands against all lawful claims.
