FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION OF Twenty one (\$21.00) dollars to us in hand paid, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, we Green Yeargain and Neta Yeargain, his wife do hereby grant to The Prairie Oil & Gas Company, its successors or assigns, the right of way to lay, maintain, operate and remove a pipe line for the transportation of oil or gas on, over and through our lands, situate in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, described as follows, to-wit:

NW 4 of SE4 and NW4 of SW4 of SE4 Section 2, Township 22 Range 12 N2 of Lot #5 Section 2, Township 22, Range 12 with ingress and egress to and from the same.
