IN THE MATTER OF THE GUARDIANSHIP OF VIOLET HARRIS, A MINOR  
ORDER CONFIRMING LEASE FOR OIL AND GAS PURPOSES.

It appearing to the Court that an order was made by this Court on the 23d day of August, 1910, authorizing and empowering the said Rube Harris, as guardian of the person and estate of Violet Harris, a minor, to execute a commercial oil and gas lease on the lands hereinafter described of said minor, to the Regent Oil and Gas Company of Tulsa, Oklahoma, that said minor is of the age of six years and is of 1/64 blood, new born citizen of the Cherokee Nation of Indians; that the guardianship of said minor is properly and regularly pending in this Court; that on the 23d day of August, 1910, and in pursuance of said order of Court, authorizing said guardian to lease said lands as aforesaid, and according to the terms and conditions thereof, the said Rube Harris, as guardian of the person and estate of said minor made and executed a commercial oil and gas lease to the Regent Oil<sup>and Gas</sup> Company, a corporation of Tulsa, Oklahoma, for oil and gas purposes, covering the following described real estate of said minor, situate in Tulsa County Oklahoma, to-wit:

The NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of the NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> and all of Lot 5, and the NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of the SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of the NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>; and the N. 15.31 acres of Lot, 6 all in section 14, Township 20 North, Range 12 East and the NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of the SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of the NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Section 13, Township 20, North, Range 12 East, containing in all 115.93 acres, more or less, same being the tentative allotment of land of said minor, as said new born citizen.

That said Regent Oil Company is the owner and holder of a departmental oil and gas lease, covering said above described real estate; that said commercial lease was made subject to confirmation by this court; that same was made for a period of five years from the date thereof and as long thereafter as oil and gas was found in paying quantities; that the said Regent Oil and Gas Company paid to the said guardian, as a bonus for said lease, the sum of One Thousand One Hundred Fifty nine and ninety three one Hundredths Dollars (\$1159.93) and agreed as additional bonus therefore to commence drilling a well upon said premises within thirty days from and after the approval of said departmental lease by the Secretary of the Interior; that said com-
