It appearing to this court from the verified petition of Sampson Seber filed herein, on the 8th day of July, 1910, that he is a full blood citizen of the Creek Nation of Indians, enrolled upon the citizenship rolls of said nation, opposite roll number 3962; that he is a brother and one of the heirs at law of Gabriel Emarthia, deceased.

That the said Gabriel Emarthia was a full blood Creek Indian as shown on the citizenship rolls of said Nation, opposite roll number 6877 and that as such citizen he had allotted to him by the commission to the Five Civilized Tribes of Indians, as his separate allotment of land, the following described real estate situate in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The Northeast quarter of Section Twelve, Township Nineteen, North, Range Eleven, East.
