sales of oil upon the principal of said note; and that the interest, after the note shall be so decreased by said payments, shall be competed upon the principal of said note as decreased.

NOW, if said party of the first part shall pay or cause to be paid to said party of the second part, its successors, grantees and assigns, said sum of money in the above described note mentioned according to the tenor thereof, together with interest thereon, then this mortgage shall be wholly discharged and void; and otherwise shall remain in full force and effect.
