But the Board of Directors of said Association may, at their option, pay or cause to be paid, the said taxes, charges, insurance, rates, and assessments so due and payable, and charge them against said grantor or assigns, and the amount so paid shall be a lien on said mortgaged premises until the same be paid, and maybe included in any judgment rendered in any proceeding, to foreclose this mortgage; but whether they elect to pay such taxes, insurance, charges, rates liens and assessments or not, it is distinctly understood that in all cases of delinquencies as above enumerated, then, in like manner, the said note and the whole of said sum shall immediately become due and payable.
