THIS AGREEMENT made this 30th day of April 1910, by and between the Jones Gas Company, party of the first part, and John F. Perry, party of the second part, WITNESSETH:

THAT IT IS HEREBY MUTUALLY AGREED BY AND BETWEEN THE parties hereto, under and pursuant to the provisions of the Act of Congress of May 27th, 1908, entitled "An act for The Removal of Restrictions from part of the lands of the Five Civilized Tribes and for other purposes", that a certain oil and gas mining lease upon the following tract of land, to wit:

All of Lot 1 excepting SE 10 A. of section 19, township 22, North of range 13 east in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and approved by the Honorable Secretary of the Interior on the 6th day of July 1906, shall be and said lease is hereby terminated, cancelled, released and held at naught.
