

7. Lease No. 7, dated May 24, 1910, from John W. Howard and wife of Bixby, Oklahoma, to Braden & Hirsh for 120 acres of land in Bixby Township, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, described as the S.E. 1/4 of the N.W. 1/4, and Lot 3, and the South twenty six acres of Lot 4, Section 2, Township 16, Range 13 East and recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, on May 25, 1910, in Record Book 79 page 644.

8.
