second party, successors, heirs, administrators, executors, and assigns, to pay said principal, interest, taxes and other assessments when and as the same shall become due, to maintain the insurance on the buildings as above provided, and to comply with faithfully with all the terms and conditions of this mortgage and that, in case of any of said taxes or other assessments shall become delinquent, or in case said first parties shall fail to maintain the insurance on said buildings as above provided, the said second party may pay said taxes and assessments and may effect such insurance, and add the amounts so paid, with interest thereon, to the indebtedness hereby secured and recover the same as a part thereof; and that, in case of foreclosure of this mortgage, a reasonable sum to be fixed by the Court, shall be recovered by said second party from said first parties as an attorney's fee, and shall be included in the decree foreclosing this mortgage.

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Said first parties hereby waive the benefit of stay, valuation or appraisment laws.
