MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 11th day of May, A. D. 1911, between Mark Hanken and Carrie Hanken of Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and Josiah M. Reinhardt of Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the second part:

WITNESSETH, That said part 1st of the first part, in consideration of Two Hundred Dollars (\$ 200.00), the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said part 2^d of the second part, her heirs and assigns, the following-described Real Estate, situated in Tulsa County, and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Lot Four (4) Block Two (2)

in body and Holloway
addition to the City of Tulsa

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said part 2^d of the second part, her heirs and assigns, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in anywise appertaining, forever.

PROVIDED, ALWAYS, And these presents are upon this express condition, that whereas, said Mark Hanken and Carrie Hanken have by this day executed and delivered their certain promissory note in writing to said part 2^d of the second part, described as follows:

One year after date we promise to pay to the order of Josiah M. Reinhardt Two Hundred Dollars for value received with interest at the rate of 10 per cent. per annum from date, and if the interest be not paid annually to become as principal and bear the same rate of interest. This note is negotiable and payable without duplication or discount and without any release or benefit whatsoever from any valuation, appraisement or homestead exemption laws signed by Mark Hanken and Carrie Hanken.

Now, if said part 1st of the first part shall pay or cause to be paid to said part 2^d of the second part, her heirs or assigns, said sum of money in the above-described note mentioned, together with the interest thereon, according to the terms and tenor of the same, then this mortgage shall be wholly discharged and void, and otherwise shall remain in full force and effect. But if said sum or sums of money or any part thereof, or any interest thereon, is not paid when the same is due, and if the taxes and assessments of every nature which are or may be assessed and levied against said premises or any part thereof are not paid when the same are by law made due and payable, the whole of said sum or sums, and interest thereon, shall then become due and payable, and said part 2^d of the second part shall be entitled to the possession of said premises. And the said part 1st of the first part for said consideration do hereby expressly waive an appraisement of said real estate and all benefit of the homestead exemption and stay laws of the State of Oklahoma.
