WARRANTY DEED

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Robert J. Allison and Ida Allison, his wife of the County of Tulsa State of Oklahoma, part of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One dollar (\$1.00) and other good and valuable consideration DOLLARS, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto William J. Cushman party of the second part the following-described real property and premises, situate in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

An undivided one half $\frac{1}{2}$ interest in and to the South East Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the South West Quarter $\frac{1}{4}$ and the East Half $\frac{1}{2}$ of the North East Quarter $\frac{1}{4}$ of the South West Quarter $\frac{1}{4}$ and the South West Quarter $\frac{1}{4}$ of the North East Quarter $\frac{1}{4}$ of the South West Quarter $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section Thirty two (32), Township twenty (20) North, and Range Fourteen (14) East of the Indian Base and Meridian, containing Seventy (70) acres more or less,

together with all the improvements thereon and the appurtenances thereunto belonging, and warrant the title to the same.

To have and to hold said described premises unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, forever; free, clear and discharged of and from all former grants, charges, taxes, judgments, mortgages and other liens and encumbrances of whatsoever nature.
