(3) Township sixteen (16) north, Range thirteen (13) East of the Indian  
Base and meridian containing forty (40) acres more or less

together with all the improvements thereon and the appurtenances thereunto belonging, and warrant the title to the same.

To have and to hold said described premises unto the said part 1/2 of the second part, Rosa heirs and assigns, forever; free, clear and discharged of and from all former grants, charges, taxes, judgments, mortgages and other liens and encumbrances of whatsoever nature.
