OIL AND GAS LEASE RECORD

Agreement. Made and entered into the 18th day of July, A. D. 1910, by and between John H. Lewis, guardian of Sallie Crosslin, a minor of Porter, Oklahoma, part y of the first part, and O.K. Eysenbach, of Tulsa, Oklahoma, part y of the second part:

WITNESSETH, That the said part y of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Eighty Dollars to him in hand well and truly paid by the said part y of the second part, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and of the covenants and agreements hereinafter contained on the part of the said part y of the second part, to be paid, kept and performed, has granted and conveyed, and by these presents do grant and convey unto the said part y of the second part, successors or assigns, for the sole and only purpose of mining and operating for oil and gas, and of laying pipe lines, and of building tanks, stations and structures thereon to take care of the said products, ALL that certain tract of land, situate in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, to-wit: North West Quarter of Section twenty eight (28) Township Eighteen (18) North Range Thirteen (13), same being the allotment of Sallie Crosslin containing 16.0 acres, more or less, reserving, however, therefrom 1.00 feet around the buildings on which no well shall be drilled by either party except by mutual consent.

It is agreed that this grant shall remain in force for the term of 11 years from this date, and as long thereafter as oil or gas, or either of them, is produced therefrom by the part y of the second part, his successors or assigns.

IN CONSIDERATION OF THE PREMISES the said part y of the second part covenant and agree as follows: 1st—To deliver to the credit of the first part his heirs and assigns, free of cost, in the pipe line to which it may connect its wells, or in tanks at the wells, or pay the market price therefor in cash, the equal 1/8 part of all oil produced and saved from these premises. And 2nd—To pay 150.00 Dollars per year for the gas from each and every gas well drilled on said premises; the product from which is marketed and used off the premises, said payments to be made on each well within sixty days after commencing to use the gas therefrom, as aforesaid, and to be paid yearly thereafter while the gas from said well is so used.

Second part y covenant and agree to locate all wells so as to interfere as little as possible with the cultivated portions of the premises.

The part y of the second part further agrees that in case no well is drilled for oil or gas within one year from the date hereof, all rights and obligations secured under this grant and demise shall cease upon three months notice in writing being served by the part y of the first part, unless the part y of the second part shall elect from year to year to continue this grant and demise in force as to any or all portions of the premises by paying in advance an annual rental of \$50.00 per acre for all of said land or such portion thereof as the part y of the second part may designate, until a well is drilled, provided that, upon the completion of said well, the above provided for rentals shall cease. Such payments shall be made direct to John H. Lewis or deposited to his credit in Porter State Bank of Porter, Okla.

IT IS AGREED that the second part y is to have the privilege of using sufficient water from the premises to run all necessary machinery, and at any time to remove all machinery and fixtures placed on said premises; and, further, upon the payment of

One DOLLARS at any time after giving three months' notice by the part y of the second part, his successors or assigns, to the part y of the first part, his heirs or assigns, said part y of the second part, his successors or assigns, shall have the right to surrender this grant for cancellation, after which all payments and liabilities thereafter to accrue under and by virtue of its terms shall cease and determine, and this grant become absolutely null and void.
