#### ORDER APPROVING OIL AND GAS MINING LEASES.

Now, on this 21st day of September, 1910, this cause coming on to be heard on the petition of A.H. Collins, as guardian of Albert H. Ely, Augusta B. Thomas J., Annie and Bessie Collins, minors, asking for an order of this Court approving two certain oil and gas mining leases executed by the said A. H. Collins as the guardian of said Minors, on certain lands hereinafter described;

And it further appearing to the Court that A.H. Collins as Guardian of Albert H. Ely H. Augusta B. Thomas J. Annie and Bessie Collins, Minors, did on the 20th day of September, 1910, execute an oil and gas mining lease on the following described land, to-wit:

The S $\frac{1}{2}$  of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  and the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of section 6, Township 20 N. range 13 E.
