ASSIGNMENT OF OIL AND GAS MINING LEASE.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That, I, P.J. White, for and in the consideration of the sum of One (1) Dollar and other valuable considerations, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and assigned and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, assign, transfer and convey unto The Lucas Oil Company a corporation of Tulsa, Oklahoma, its successors or assigns, all my right, title, and interest in and to a certain oil and gas mining lease covering the West half of the Northwest quarter (W $\frac{1}{2}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Six (6) Township Eighteen (18) and Range Thirteen (13) of Tulsa County, Oklahoma.
