RIGHT OF WAY.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That Annis E. Nixon and William E. Nixon, husband and wife, of Tulsa Oklahoma, in consideration of the sum of One Dollar to them in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, and convey unto Delfa J. Carson, heirs, assigns and grantees, a right of way for private road ten feet in width, on, along, and across the west end of the following described property, to-wit:

The South one half of the NW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 32, in Township 20, North, of Range 13 East, in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma.

To have and to hold the same as a way of egress and ingress to and from the North 1/2 of the NW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of said section section, township and range, now owned by the said Delfa J. Carson, so long as same shall be necessary for that purpose; but in the event said passage way shall be abandoned by said Delfa J. Carson, or her grantees, or in case a public highway shall be opened up to afford an outlet from said last described tract, then said right of way shall cease, and said strip of land shall revert to the parties of the first part, their heirs or assigns free and discharged of said
