# ASSIGNMENT OF OIL AND GAS LEASE.

This instrument made and entered into this 2d day of May, 1910, by and between J.E. Prosser, and W.L. Knight, of Tulsa, Oklahoma, partners under the firm name and style of Prosser & Knight, parties of the first part, and G.C. Simmons, and W.P. Miles of Tulsa, Oklahoma, parties of the second part, WITNESSETH:

That Whereas, on the 4th day of October, 1909, Melessee Thomas, as guardian of Joseph Perryman and Ralph Perryman, minors, executed and delivered to the Daisy Bell Oil Company, a corporation, a certain oil and gas mining lease covering the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 27, Township 18 North, Range 12 East of the Indian Base and Meridian; and

Whereas, the said Daisy Belle Oil Company has by an instrument of writing dated the 20th day of April, 1910, agreed to transfer and assign unto the first parties an undivided  $\frac{7}{16}$  interest in and to the aforesaid oil and gas lease and the leasehold estate thereby created upon certain conditions therein set forth, and

Whereas, the said Daisy Belle Oil Company has by an instrument of writing of date April 22, 1910, which has been deposited in escrow at the Exchange National Bank of Tulsa, Oklahoma, to be delivered to the first parties upon the happening of the conditions therein set forth, transferred, assigned and conveyed unto the first parties an undivided  $\frac{7}{16}$  interest in and to the aforesaid oil and gas lease and the leasehold estate thereby created;

Now, Therefore, for and in consideration of One Dollar cash in hand paid and other good and valuable considerations, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the said first parties hereby transfer, sell, assign and convey unto the second parties an undivided  $\frac{3}{16}$  interest in and to the aforesaid oil and gas lease and the leasehold estate thereby created.

To have and to hold the said undivided  $\frac{3}{16}$  interest in and to said oil and gas lease and the leasehold estate thereby created unto the said G.C. Simmons and W.P. Miles, their heirs and assigns, during the full term of said lease and subject to its provisions and conditions.
