OIL AND GAS LEASE.

IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of Fifty two & 50/100 dollars, the receipt and payment of which is hereby acknowledged by the first parties, Walter M. Stunkard and Charles Stunkard, parties of the first part do hereby grant and convey unto second part- all the oil and gas in and under the premises herein after described, together with said premises for the purpose and with the exclusive right to enter thereon at all times by himself, agents, assigns or employees, to drill and operate wells for oil, gas and water and to erect, maintain and occupy, repair and remove all buildings, telephone poles and wires, structures, pipelines, machinery and appliances that second party may deem necessary or expedient to the production of oil, gas and water thereon, and the transportation of oil, gas and water upon and over said premises and the highways along the same, except that first parties shall have the full 1/8 part of all oil produced and saved on the premises, and first parties agree to accept said share of said oil as full compensation for all the products of each well in which oil is found. Said real estate and premises are located-----County of Tulsa and described as follows, to-wit: Southeast one fourth (1/4) of Southeast one fourth (1/4) of Section Six (6) Twp. Eighteen (18) Range Thirteen (13) East, in the Creek Nation, The fractional west one half (1/2) of the Northwest one fourth (1/4) of Section Seven (7) Twp. Eighteen (18) Range Thirteen (13) East, in the Creek Nation.

The above described land does not cover any part of the homesteads of the said first parties.
