KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS That whereas on the----day of December 1905 a lease was executed by Maggie Jones nee McIntosh, and V.T. To have and to hold the same to itself and assigns for the residue of the term of years mentioned in the said oil and gas lease under the yearly rent and covenant within reserved and contained, on our part and behalf to be done, kept and performed.
