It is further agreed that all such improvements made for agricultural purposes aforesaid shall remain and be the property of the party of the second part, and should the party of the second part be deprived of said land or any part thereof before the expiration of this contract, then and in either event he shall have the privilege of ramoving said structures and improvements or disposing of them as he may see fit, but if he shall be permitted to have the use of the premises for the full period provided herein and this contract shall have been fully completed in conformity with the terms herein expressed then said structures and other improvements shall be turned over and delivered to the party of the first part in good condition, and repair less ordinary wear and tear.

It is further agreed that this contract and its stipulations shall be binding upon our respective heirs and legal representatives.
