This matter came on to be heard before me Preslie B. Cole, judge of the District Court in and for McIntosh County, Oklahoma, this 25th day of April, 1910, upon application and petition of Wilton Pemberton by his next friend Washington Pemberton to have the rights of majority conferred upon said Wilton Pemberton a minor, and it appearing to the court that due legal notice of this application has been given for publication for two successive weeks prior to presenting this application, in a newspaper printed in said county, and state, and the court having heard the evidence in open court, finds that the petitioner is of the age of 18 years, that he is of sound mind and fully able, and competent to transact his own affairs, and that the interests of said petitioner will be materially promoted by granting the prayer of said petition, and that the said Wilton Pemberton has been an actual resident of this state for one year, next preceding the filing of this petition, and is at the present time a resident of McIntosh County, It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the court, In pursuance of the authority conferred by Sec. 3833 Stat. 1903, that the majority concerning contracts be and the same are hereby conferred upon said Wilton Pemberton, and said Wilton Pemberton is hereby authorized and empowered to transact business in general, and especially to convey any real estate that he may own as tho' he were a person over the age of 21 years of age.
