In the matter of the Guardianship of Wiley Gaskine, minor, G.W. Hutchins, Guardian ORDER CONFIRMING SALE OF REAL ESTATE.

Now on this 27th day of September, 1910, there coming on for hearing & the return of sale made by G.W. Hutchins, as guardian of the estate of the above named minor, and it being proven to the satisfaction of the court that the said return of sale of real estate, under order of sale hereinbefore made, was duly filed in the office of the Clerk of this Court on the 15th day of September 1910; that on said 15th day of September, 1910 the Court made an order fixing the 27th day of September 1910 at 9 o'clock A.M. as the day for hearing thereof and the clerk of this Court on the said15th day of September, 1910 gave notice of said hearing by causing notices to be posted in the form and manner as required by law and the said order of court; and thereupon after examining the return and hearing the evidence, the court finds therefrom that said sale was legally made and and fairly conducted; that notice of the time, place and terms of said sale was duly given in the manner and form as prescribed by law and by order of this Court, and that said notices described said land as the same is hereinafter described; that said land was appraised within one year of said sale, and that the price obtained at such sale is a t least ninety per cent of the appraised value; and thereupon in open court, J.E.
