## Oil Lease.

THIS CONTRACT AND AGREEMENT made and entered into this the 19th day of September, 1910, by and between Frank Phillips as guardian of Ula Maude Phillips and B. Rush Norvell, does,

WITNESS That, WHEREAS, The East Half of the West Half of the North east Quarter of the North east quarter (E/2 of W/2 of NE/4 of NW/4) of Section One (1) Township Twenty one (21) North, Range Twelve (12) East, containing ten (10) acres more or less, was intended to be included in an oil and gas mining lease made by Frank Phillips, as guardian of said Ula Maude Phillips, to W.A. Stuart, and W.A. Stuart assigned to the Stuart Oil Company, and of which said lease B. Rush Norvell is now the owner and holder, but said land was left out of said lease through mistake of parties drawing lease in describing the lands intended to be set out in said lease.

NOW, THEREFORE it is agreed on by and between the parties hereto that said lease may be amended so as to include said above described land, and that said above described lands shall be held to be bound and subject to all the terms, conditions, and stipulations of said original lease, the same as if it had been included therein, and that said B. Rush Norvell has the same right to develop and operate said above described lands for oil and gas, and to exercise on and in connection with said lease all the rights and authority he would exercise on and in connection therewith, the same as if said land had been included in said original lease, and that this instrument shall be taken and held to be a part of said lease.
