That portion of the fractional SW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 (known as Lot 7) of Sec. 2, Twp. 19 N. R. 12 E. lying South of a line drawn from the NW corner of the SE corner of said Lot 7, and

Lot 2 of Sec 11, Twp 19 N.R. 13 E.
