Josey the following described real property and premises, situate in Creek County, State of Oklahoma, to-wit

The South East Quarter of Section Thirty six (36) Township Nineteen (19) North Range Eleven (11) East, containing one hundred and sixty (160) acres together with all the improvements thereon and the appurtenances thereunto belonging.

To have and to hold the said described premises unto the said grantee, their heirs, and assigns forever.
