Spurgeon, Guardian by The Gulf Pipe Line Company of Oklahoma, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged I do hereby grant and convey unto said Gulf Pipe Line Company of Oklahoma, its successors and assigns, the right to locate maintain and operate a pipe line for the purpose of conveyance of oil over, through and upon thatthat certain tract of land situated in Tulsa County, Oklahoma and thus described: SEt of SEt of NEt Sec. 26, T 22 N.R. 12 E. 40 rods.

Also there is hereby granted a right to erect and maintain a telephone and telegraph line.
