GUARDIAN'S DEED.

THIS INDENTURE, made the 13th day of October, 1910, by and between Lee H. Tackett, the duly appointed, qualified and acting guardian of the estates of Pansy Patton, and Silas Patton, minors, party of the first part, and Kirk Lewis, and Carl Lewis, parties of the second part, Witnesseth:
