Second party hereby conveys the oil and oil rights under the North half of Northwest quarter of Sec. 34, Township 18 N, Range 13 E., conveyed to him by lease dated June 4th 1910 made by B. F. M. Klump subject to the conditions as to the rights of all parties hereto as set out herein above?
