With Relinquishment of Dower

COMPARED

THIS INDENTURE, made this 26th day of Feby A.D. 1910, between W.H. Clow and Myrtle Clow, his wife of Dawson, Okla. party of the first part, and Lydia Clow, of Dawson, Okla. party of the second part, witnesseth, that the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred and No/100 Dollars dollars, in hand paid by the said party of the second part (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has remise, released, sold, conveyed and quitclaimed and by these presents does remise, release, sell, convey and quitclaim unto the said party of the second part, her heirs and assigns, forever, all the right, title, interest, claim and demand which said party of the first part has in and to the following described lot, piece or parcel of land or improvements, situated in the County of Tulsa State of Oklahoma and known and described as follows, to-wit:

All of Lots Nos. Thirteen (13) Fourteen (14) and Fifteen (15) in Block No. Eleven (11) in the town of Dawson, Okla. with all improvements thereon, according to the recorded amended plat thereof.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the appurtenances and privileges thereunto belonging or appertaining and all the estate, right, title, interest and claim whatever of the said parties of the first part, either in law or equity, to the only proper use, Benefit and Behoof of the said party of the second part her heirs and assigns forever.

And I, Myrtle Clow wife of the said W.H. Clow for and in consideration of the said Sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Lydia Clow all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
