#### DEED OF DEDICATION

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS. That The Tulsa Addition Company, a corporation, with its principal place of business in the City of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, for value received, hereby dedicates to the said City of Tulsa, and to the public, for use as a public street, a parcel of land situated in said city of Tulsa, County of Tulsa, and State of Oklahoma, and more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

All that portion of Lots One (1) and Eight (8) in block Ninety five (95) as shown on the original plat of the town of Tulsa, included within the following boundaries, to-wit: Commencing at a point on the West line of Frisco Avenue and 24.4 feet South of the Northeast Corner of said lot one (1) thence South 66° 45' West, 88.5 feet to the Right of Way of the Saint Louis and San Francisco Railroad Company, thence Southwesterly along the right of way of said Railroad Company 231 feet, thence South along the East line of Guthrie Avenue 1.7 feet to the North line of Lot two (2) of said block Ninety five (95) extended westerly to intersect the East line of Guthrie Avenue, thence Easterly along the north line of said lot two (2) and its Westerly extension to the West line of Frisco Avenue, thence northerly along the west line of Frisco Avenue to place of Beginning.

Said corporation hereby releases said city of Tulsa, and all persons from all damage, by reason of the laying out and opening up of said street.
