Witness That, WHEREAS, on the 4th day of December, 1909, parties of the second part herein were justly indebted to the party of the first part in the sum of Six Thousand Five Hundred (\$6500.00) dollars, such indebtedness being evidenced by four (4) promissory notes of said J.A. Hull of said date, and each being for the sum of One Thousand Six Hundred Twenty five (\$1,625.00) Dollars, bearing interest at the rate of eight (8) per cent per annum, falling due respectively in six (6) twelve (12) eighteen (18) and twenty four (24) months, and in order to secure said indebtedness, parties of the second part signed, executed and delivered to the party of the first part their certain mortgage dated December 4th, 1909, and covering lots Six (6) and seven in Block Three of the Friend Gillette addition to the city of Tulsa, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, situated on the northwest corner of Twelfth and Main Streets Which said mortgage was duly filed for record with the register of deeds of Tulsa County, Oklahoma and recorded in Book 73, on page 457 of the records of said office; and,

WHEREAS, the indebtedness evidenced by the said above described promissory notes and secured by said mortgage has been duly paid, satisfied and discharged.

Leovy hereby grant, bargain, quitclaim, release, sell and convey unto the parties of the second part all the right, title, interest, and estate I acquired in and to said above described land by reason of said above named mortgage, and do hereby acknowledge the same to be paid, satisfied and discharged in full, and release and relinquish unto the parties of the second part herein all my right, title interest and estate in and to said above named mortgage.
