THIS INDENTURE OF LEASE, Made and entered into, in quadruplicate on this @26th day of May A.D. 1906, by and between Thomas D. Taylor, Guardian of Daniel O. Taylor, a minor, of Collinsville, Indian Territory, party of the first part, and Mohawk Oil Company, a corporation organized and existing under the laws in force in the Indian Territory of Battlesville, Indian Territory, party of the second part, under and in pursuance of the provisions of Section 72 of the act of Congress approved July 1, 1902 and the regulations prescribed by the Secretary of the Inttrior thereu nder.

Witnesseth: That the party of thefirst part for and in consideration of the royalties, covenants, stipulations and conditions hereinafter contained, and hereby agreed to be paid, observed and performed by the party of the second part, its successors and assigns do hereby demise, grant and let unto the party of the second part, its successors and assigns for the term of years ending September 30, 1916, from the date hereof, all of the oil deposits and natural gas in or under the following described tract of land, lying and being within the Cherokee Nation and within the Indian merritory, to-wit: The S/2 of NW/4 of NE/4 and NE/4 of NW/4 of Section 25, Township 22 North, Range 12 East, and NE/4 of NE/4 of Section eight (8) Township twenty one ! [21) North, range thirteen (13) East, of the Indian Meridian and containing seventy (70) acres, more or less, with the right to prospect for, extract, pipe, store, refine and remove such oil and natural gas, and to occupy and use so much only of the surface of said land as may be reasonably necessary to carry on the work of prospecting for, extracting, piping, storing, refining and removing such coil and natural gas, including also the right to obtain from wells or other sources on said land, by means of pipe lines or otherwise a sufficient supply of water to carry on said operations, and including still further the right to use such vil and natural gas as fuel so far as it is necexxary to the prosecution of said operations.
