ORDER

Comes now this matter on for hearing upon the petition of Thomas White and J. K. Ronne, for a correction of an error in the description of the land hereinafter described.

And the court finds that on the 9th day of February, 1910, pursuant to an order of this Court S.J. Keys, as guardian of James M. Keys, a minor, executed and delivered to Thomas White and J.K. Ronne, a certain oil and gas lease upon the following described property, to-wit:
