OIL AND GAS MINING LEASE.

THIS INDENTURE, made the 29th day of October, 1910, by and between W.A. Skaggs of Skiatook, Oklahoma, the duly appointed, qualified and acting guardian of the person and estate of Roy Skaggs, a minor, party of the first part, and Morris Shear, of Warren, Pennsylvania, party of the second part, WITNESSETH:-

THAT, WHEREAS, on the 7th day of December, 1908 the County Court within and for said County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, made an order of sale authorizing the said party of the first part to sell an oil and gas mining lease upon the allotment of the said minor ward, situate in Tulsa County State of Oklahoma, and specified and particularly described in said order of sale and which said order of sale now on file and of record in said county court, is hereby referred to and made a part of this indenture.

AND WHEREAS, under and by virtue of said order of sale and pursuant to legal notice given thereof, the said party of the first part on the 16th day of December, 1908, at the County Court in the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, at the hour of 10:30 o'clock in the forenoon, offered at private sale an oil and gas mining lease to the highest and best bidder for cash, said oil and gas mining lease covering lands situated in the said county of Tulsa to-wit: N/2 of SW/4 of Section 5, Township 21 North, Range 13 East, and that at such sale the Leola Oil Company was the highest bidder for the said oil and gas mining lease hereinafter particularly described, in the sum of \$2575 cash
