THIS INDENTURE, Made the 24th day of August, A.D. 1910 between A.P. Fillpot, and Alma H. Fillpot, his wife, of Whittier, California, the parties of the first part, and West Tulsa Belt Railway Company, a corporation, the party of the second part,

Witnesseth, that the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Ten (\$10) dollars, lawful money of the United States of America, to us in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part, and to its successors and assigns forever, all that certain lots pieces or parcels of land situate, lying and being in the town of West Tulsa, County -----State of Oklahoma, and bounded and particularly described as follows, to-wit:
