WAIVER OF OBLIGATION UNDER BOND.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That, whereas, on the 15th day of October, 1908, the Secretary of the Interior approved an oil and gas mining lease on the allotment of W.A. McKim said allotment embracing the following described lands:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 29, T 17 N. R. 14 E., 40 acres, more or less, in Tulsa County, Okla. said lease being dated June 10th 1908 and made by W.A. McKim in favor of Lowland Oil and Gas Company, a corporation, and

Whereas, the said Lowland Oil and Gas Company, made and executed a bond to the United States of America in the sum of One thousand Dollars (\$1000.00) conditioned upon the said Lowland Oil and Gas Company's faithfully performing all the obligations and conditions of the aforesaid lease and observing all the laws of the United States and regulation thereunder made by the Secretary of the Interior; and

McKim, for and in consideration of the sum of One dollar (\$1.00) the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby relieve and release the United States of America from all further obligations and duties under said lease to Lowland Oil and Gas Company and under said bond made by the National Surety Company, as surety, and

Do Hereby Substitute for the United States Indian Agent, Union Agency Muskogee, Oklahoma, the Bank of Bixby, Bixby, Oklahoma, as a place of payment of the rentals and royalties under said lease, do hereby authorize the lessee and his assigns to pay all rentals and royalties falling due under said lease at the said-----Bank, of Bixby, Bixby, Oklahoma, to the owner of the said land.
