J.A. Calloway and E.M. Carter being first duly sworn, upon their oaths depose and say: They are the parties of the second part to a certain deed from Phillis Johnson and Joe Johnson to J.A. Calloway, and E.M. Carter, dated about the 18 day of October 1909, and purporting to convey to the said J.A. Calloway and E.M. Carter, a one half (1/2) interest in and to the following described tract of land, to-wit:

The North east Quarter (NE4) of the North west Quarter (NW4) of Section Twenty (20) Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Fourteen (14) East, in Tulsa County, and consisting of forty (40) acres.

That said deed conveyed to them only one third (1/3) interest each, in and to the said one half (1/2) interest in and to the said forty (40) acres; the other one third (1/3) interest in and to said one half (1/2) interest in and to the said forty (40) acres described by said deed, was intended, and of right ought to belong to one R.S. Gamble, of Okmulgee, Oklahoma, whose name should have been placed upon said deed with said J.A. Calloway and E.M. Carter.

That we have never claimed nor do now claim to hold a deed to the whole one half (1/2) interest in said the land described in said deed; but only one third (1/3) interest each as aforesaid.

That we have sold only our one third (1/3) interest each in and to said twenty (20) acres, to George C. Beidleman, and that he has no title from us to the other one third (1/3) interest in and to said twenty (20) acres; but only the one third (1/3) interest each, which we sold to him.
