And it further appearing to this court from the petition of Eli Bell filed herein on the 16th day of April, 1910, and the petition of Silby B ell filed on April 21st, 1910, that the said Silla B ell did die without issue or husband surviving her. And the court having heard the evidence and being satisfied that by a clerical ommission of the word "OR" in the order heretofore entered, was made, and the Court being fully advised in the premises finds that the said Silla Bell aid not leave a husband surviving her, and that the order heretofore made is vague and misleading and that it clou ds t he title to said land, and it appearing that the proceedings are regular and that the said mistake should be corrected.

It further appearing to the court that Silla Bell was the owner of the Southwest quarter of the Northeast Quarter and Lots one and two and the Southeast quarter off the Northeast quarter of Section 6, Township 19 North, Range 11, East, containing in all 118.7 7 acres more or less, and that the order was the order approving the deed of Eli B ell to his interest in the above described land, andthat the omission of the word "OR" makes it appear that she left a husband surviving her and from the petitions and the evidence and the application of E.R. Kemp, and other evidence offered, it appears that the said Silla Bell did not leave a husband, and that the order heretofore made reciting "Husband surviving her" was an error and should be corrected.

It is therefore Ordered, adjudged and decreed that the order of the said court filed herein be correct.ed to read "without issue or husband surviving her" and that this order take precedence over the former order and be entered as of the 16th day of April, 1910.
