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COMPIRED

LEASE CONTRACT.

This agreement made this 3rd day of November 1910, by and between Maggie D. McKim of Bixby, Okla., party of the first part, and J.F. Pautler of Bixby, Okla., party of the second part.

WITNESSETH: party of the first part, hereby and by these presents, lets, leases and demised unto the second party, his heirs or assigns, for agricultural purposes, for the term of five (5) years from and after the first day of January 1911, for and in consideration of the sum of One & no/100 (\$1.00) Dollars, and other valuable consideration paid to said first party by party of the second part, and the receipt of which consideration is hereby acknowledged by said party of the first part, the following described tract of land to-wit:

All of that portion or part of the south half (1/2) of the South West Quarter (1/4) of Section Twenty nine (29) in Township Seventeen (17) North and Range Fourteen (14) East, of the Indian Meridian in Tulsa County, Oklahoma located and situate on the south side of the Midland Valley Rail Road Company present Right of Way, across said described Quarter Section: containing Fortynine (49) acres, more or less.

It is agreed that said second party shall deliver up possession of above said premises, with all improvements, at the expiration of above said term of five (5 ) years, without further notice on the part of the said first party.
