OIL AND GAS MINING LEASE UPON LAND SELECTED FOR ALLOTMENT CHEROKEE NATION INDIAN TERRITORY.

(Sec 72, Act of July 1, 1902, 32 Stat 716, 726)

THIS INDENTURE OF LEASE, made and entered into, in quadruplicate on this 26th day of June A.D. 1906 by and between Ella Parris of Chance, Indian Territory part-- of the first part, lessor, and Sagamore Oil and Gas Company incorporated under the laws of South Dakota of Buffalo, N.Y. party of the second part, lessee, under and in pursuance of the provisions of section 72 of the act of Congress approved July 1, 1902, and the regulations prescribed by the Secretary of the Interior thereunder.

WITNESSETH, that the party of the first part, for and in consideration of the royalties, covenants, stipulations and conditions hereinafter contained, and hereby agreed to be paid, observed and performed by the party
