DEED OF RELEASE.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That W.E. Privett a single man of Bixby, Tulsa County, Okla., for and in consideration of the sum of Fourteen Hundred dollars to me paid by Mrs M.A. Brown, a widow, of Bixby, Oklahoma, do hereby grant, sell, quit claim and release unto the said Mrs. M.A. Brown a widow, and undo her heirs and assigns, forever, & the following described real estate situated in the county of Tulsa, and state of Oklahoma, to-wit: SW/4 of Section 4, Township 16 North, Range 13 East, containing 160 acres, more or less, according to the U.S. Government survey thereof.

This deed being made to release the lien of a certain mortgage dated the Ninth day of September 1900 and recorded in the Register of Deeds office in Tulsa County and state of Oklahoma, on the 10th day of September 1910, in Book 28 at page 436 said mortgage having been given by Mrs. M.A. Brown, a widow, of Bixby, Oklahoma, conveying said real estate to W.E. Privett, a single man, of Bixby, Oklahoma, to secure the payment of a notes for the sum of \$1400, therein named, the same having been fully paid.
