That he is the identical person named in a certain warranty deed, executed by Dollie B. Watson, on the 23d day of January, 1904, and recorded, February 2, 1904, in Book 3, Page 70, in the office of the Deputy Clerk and Ex Officio Register of Deeds at Sapulpa, Indian Territory, and afterwards recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, at 3:05 P.M. on November 3d, 1910, That the same deed is recorded in both places. That there has never been any alteration therein, and that the record in the office at Sapulpa is in error.
