

said notes at maturity, that the said party of the first part shall hold as security her equity, in said business until said notes are paid;

It is mutually agreed that should either of the parties hereto make personal use of any horse and buggy on Sunday, that the same price shall be charged to their account as would be charged a regular customer; but at all other times the parties hereto may have use of horses or driving outfits as a matter of courtesy;

The party of the first part shall make monthly settlement as near the 10th day of each month as possible, showing the financial condition of the business and physical condition of the outfit.
