This lease may be surrendered by mailing to the lessor as above. And all money accruing to lessor under this contract may be paid by check or cash direct to any one of the lessor or mailed to lessor at Muskogee, Okla, or payment may be made through, bank

It is agreed that all the terms and conditions hereof shall extend and apply to the heirs, executors, administrators and assigns of the parties hereto.
