And the court further finds that the above described lands are in what is known as the oil and gas belt and that it would be to the best interests of said minors and their estates that good and valid oil and gas leases should be sold for oil and gas leases, and that said leases should be confirmed by this court, in order that said minors may have an income to pay for their support, maintenance and education, and for the security or improvement of the lands belonging to said minors, and that if said lands are found to be productive of oil and gas and paying oil and gas wells, an income for said minors may be derived therefrom.

And the Court further finds that all necessary notices of a sale of oil and gas leases in this matter have been properly given according to the laws of the State of Oklahoma.

And the court further finds that the said guardian did, on the 20th day of December 1910 in the city of Claremore, County of Rogers described premises, at private sale, to the highest and best bidder, and that at such sale the Paulding Oil and Gas Company, was the highest and best bidder, bidding therefor among other things, one-eighth royalty for the oil and one hundred fifty (\$150.00) dollars per annum for the gas wells when the gas is used off the premises, and a cash bonus of One (\$1.00) per acre, ~~and that~~ thereafter the said guardian did execute and deliver oil and gas leases of date the 20th day of December 1910 covering the land above described unto the Paulding Oil and Gas Company

Now, Therefore, it is by the Court considered, ordered, adjudged and decreed that the oil and gas leases executed by said William N. Blakemore, guardian of Gracie C. Blakemore, Oce Blakemore, Willie Starkley and Henry Starkey, minors, unto the Paulding Oil and Gas Company of date the 20th day of December 1910, shall be and the same are in all their terms, covenants, agreements and conditions, ratified, confirmed, approved and declared valid.
