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Now on this 20th day of December 1910, this matter coming on for hearing for the confirmation of a certain oil and gas lease executed by William N. Blakemore, guardian of the persons and estates of Gracie D. Blakemore, Oce Blakemore, Willie Starkey and Henry Starkey, minors, to The Paulding Oil and Gas Company upon the allotments of said minors-situated in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, authorized and empowered in pursuance of an order of this Court made on the 20th day of December 1910

And the said minors appearing by their guardian William N. Blakemore, and testimony being taken in open Court, and the Court being fully advised in the premises finds:

That the said William N. Blakemore, the duly appointed , qualified and acting guardian of said minors, and that their father, the guardian herein, and their mother Sarah E. Blakemore are the next of kin of said minors and are the only persons interested in this matter and have filed herein their written waiver for the hearing of the petition for the sale of oil and gas leases abve referred to and requiring the execution of said leases by said guardian upon the lands of said minors as hereinafter described. And the Court further finds that the said minors are the owners of the following described premises, to-wit:
