RENTAL CONTRACT.

This agreement, made and entered into this 29 day of October, 1910, by and between Jane Grayson, guardian of David Grayson, of Haskell, Okla., Part of the first Part, and A. J. Burchett, Lenard, Oklahoma, Party of the second Part.

Witnesseth, that for and in consideration of the covenants and agreements hereinafter made the Party of the first Part has let, leased and demised and does by these Presents let, lease and demise unto the Party of the second Part, for agricultural Purposes, for the term of Five (5) years from and after the 29 day of October, 1910, the following described tracts of land lying in the county of Tulsa, state of Oklahoma.

The said Party of the second Part, for the use of the said land, agrees to pay to the party of the first Part as rent, Per annum during the term of this contract, Two (\$2.00) Per acre Per year for all land now in cultivation on the above described Premises.
